## Specific Conditions

## Level of Evidence

Insufficient data (Category 4a)

Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIg) may be indicated in certain highly selected cases where other treatments have not been effective.

**The aim should be to use the lowest dose possible that achieves the appropriate clinical outcome for each patient.**
